

## **B.** Identify management requirements and prepare a plan

After site values have been assessed, it is possible to work out priorities and requirements for management and to develop a conservation management plan. The management aims and desired results will vary, depending on the conservation significance of the site, land uses and the personal requirements of the landholder.

Decisions for the land manager	Examples
Management aims and desired results for each management unit	Increase regeneration of native plants.
Management activities for each of these units	Exclude livestock periodically by erecting secure fencing; undertake a weed contro program in the unit.
Priorities for management between and within management units	Secure fencing first to ensure stock are contained. Treat the weeds once the movement of stock is controlled.

Guidelines for determining aims are in Step 7. Step 8 assists in identifying specific management issues and actions to address the issues. The general management principles enclosed help to determine management activities that assist in enhancing conservation significance. Publications and agencies that can help with development of management plans are listed in the reference section. After identifying issues important for conservation and ecological functioning, a work program needs to be developed to ensure that the plan can be implemented.

Step 9 shows how to develop a work program to carry out the activities identified in Step 8.
